



### ***AcessRescue COVID-19 Plan***

As we navigate these uncertain times AcessRescue remains committed to the safety of its students and instructors. We continue to be guided by the emergency guidelines of the state of New Jersey as well as the CDC and as such we will be resuming classes in June with the following changes to institute social distancing measures and help prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Student temperatures will be taken with an infrared (no touch) thermometer at the start of each day, after lunch before resuming class, and at the end of class. Anyone with a temperature in excess of 100.4 will be given the opportunity to retake a class at least 21 days later at no charge.
- Masks and gloves will be available to all students during all AcessRescue classes. If you have a preference, you are encouraged to bring your own.
- Students who have their own helmet with chinstrap are encouraged to bring them to class. AcessRescue helmets will still be available for anyone who needs them.
- Learning in our classroom will be limited to no more than 6 students and one instructor. All but six chairs will be removed from the classroom to enforce this. Classroom instruction for larger classes will be held on the open training floor.
- Many of our skills props will be taken out of service to keep students spread out during practical skills and practice.
- Students will have designated props assigned to them to perform their skills to minimize students having contact with the same ropes.
- Students will also have dedicated equipment caches including a set of ropes to minimize sharing of equipment between students.
- Each student will have their own area for storing equipment and personal possessions.
- We will have floor markings for where students stand while observing demonstrations.
- Frequent handwashing will be required and encouraged. We have two handwashing stations which have distance markers placed on the floor.
- Practical skills practice will be limited to one person operations and dummy weights will be used for all rescues.
- AcessRescue is following all manufacturer guidelines and instructions for cleaning equipment and will whenever possible, use different sets of equipment between different classes. No piece of equipment will be reused without a minimum of 72 hours downtime.

These measures will remain in effect until the CDC and the state of New Jersey deems them no longer necessary.
